7. To inform the members of current economic, social, political, and educational issues so that they may participate effectively in a world society

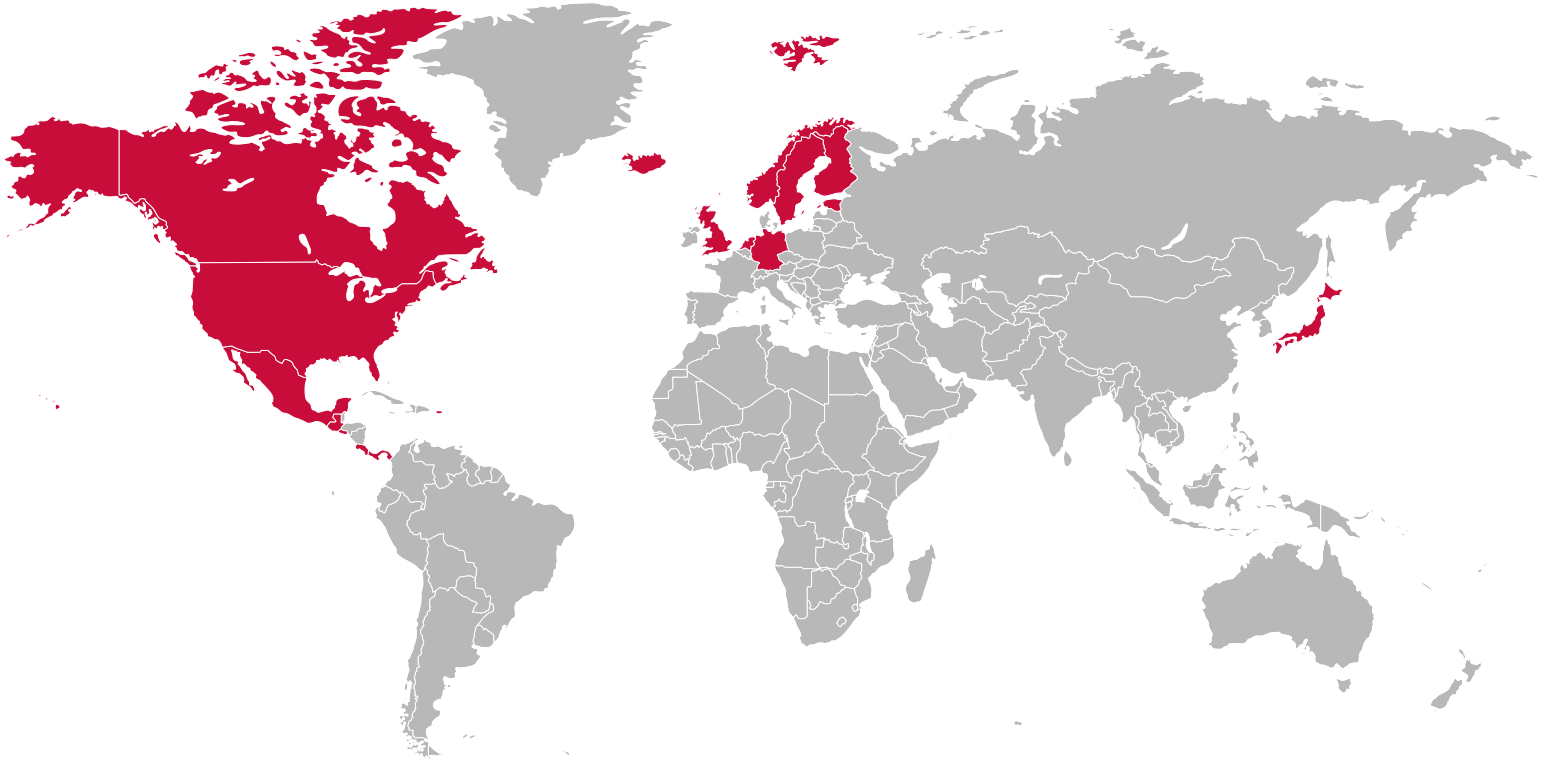
