Legislation

The Legislation Committee would like your help in letting your chapter members know about the importance of voting on November 7th. There are 14 constitutional amendments that need to be voted on. A key one for retired public-school annuitants is Proposition 9 – HJR 2, regular session "The constitutional amendment authorizing the 88th Legislature to provide a cost-of-living adjustment to certain annuitants of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas." Note: Annuitant is a person receiving a monthly annuity from TRS such as a retiree, surviving spouse or beneficiary. Sylvia Salinas, our Area 5 Coordinator will have SOAR pins available for sale at our Tri-Chapter Birthday meeting. They are \$5 each.


